***School Improvement plan goal #1. was discussed and two changes were made to it; Change #1. (with an emphasis on the third grade) was added to our reading goal. Change #2. On 3 e. - Waterford for tutoring help was deleted.*

*** Our test results from last year on C.R.T. tests, reading benchmarks, Dibels Reading, and the D.W.A. writing assessment were all discussed. Academic achievement concerns were mainly focused on our special ed., E.L.L. and our third grade reading scores.*

Efforts are being made to improve those scores using Title I technicians, Trustland's technicians, Success Maker, chrome books, Imagine Learning and special education for those who qualify.

***The possibility of getting a grant from the Nebo Foundation to purchase a set of calculators was discussed as a way to help teach some upper grade math skills and will be looked into.*

***It was mentioned that our students did extremely well on the D.W.A. writing assessment.*

***It was mentioned that Amy Staheli would be taking Krista Sexton's place as the councils P.T.A. representative.*

***Sheryl Hazelet reported on the District Council Meeting that she attended – She mentioned some of the problems that Obama Care had made for some school employees, the problems facing Payson High and other schools that have higher numbers of fee waivers, student progress, and some other concerns that the Superintendent talked about.*
