 - A Robotics program sponsored by U.V.U was discussed and a motion was made by Joanie Burningham to try and bring the program to the school. A second was made by Leslie Baguley. The council unanimously voted to try and bring the program to Goshen School.
 - Who would be able to be on next year's council was discussed. (We have a full council and will not need to do elections next year)
 - The council decided to wait until September to elect new co-chairs.
 - It was decided to hold the first S.C.C. meeting next school year at the end of Aug, or the first part of Sept.
 - Travis Proctor reported what the school was doing to promote healthy lifestyles for students' and teachers.
