KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Kindergarten Registration for the 2013-2014 school year will be held on Tuesday, **March 13th from 8:00 a.m.** to **4:00 p.m.** Please bring your kindergartener with you. We will do an academic prescreening while you are completing the registration forms.

REMEMBER to complete registration you must present an *official birth certificate issued by the county*, *immunization records*, *and evidence of residency* when you come. If you do not bring the immunization record your student may be registered, but **will not be assigned a teacher until the required immunizations are documented or unless there is an immunization exemption form signed.

Please help us by informing neighbors, friends and relatives who do not currently have children in school.

Immunizations Clinics

There will be am Immunization clinic on March 12/ 12:00 PM -4:00 PM at Larsen Elementary in Spanish Fork . March 13/ 12:00 PM -4:00 PM at Taylor Elementary in Payson, March 14/ 12:00 PM -4:00 PM at Cherry Creek Elementary in Springville, March 21/ 3:00 PM -5:00 PM at Santaquin Elementary in Santaquin, and April 24/2:30 PM – 5:00 PM at Taylor Elementary in Payson. VFC vaccine is available for \$14.00 per shot for those 18 and under who do not have insurance, **Tdap (required for 7th grade) as well as Flu, Hepatitis A&B, Pneumococcal, Varicalla, HPV, MMR, Dtap, Polio, and Meningococcal**. They will also offer kindergarten shots to kindergarten age students. Cost will be determined by insurance coverage. Please remember to bring immunization records with you. If you have any questions, please contact Goshen School 801-667-3361 or the Utah County Health Department at 851-7045. Flyers are available in the office at the school which include accepted insurance list.
